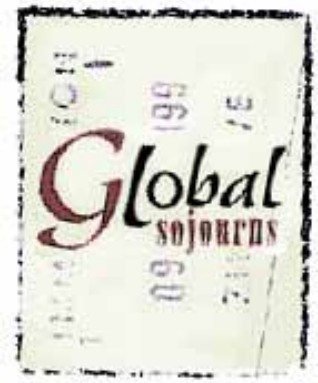




All Women's Safari Adventure

May 9th - 21st, 2010



OKAVANGO DELTA - MOREMI - CHOBE RIVER - VICTORIA FALLS
South Africa - Botswana - Namibia - Zambia

May 9th

Once you have arrived at OR Tambo Airport in Johannesburg, you will be met in the arrivals hall after you have cleared customs and collected your luggage, for a road transfer to the Safari Club. The transfer time is approximately 10 minutes.

In: May 9th Out: May 10th

1 Night at the Safari Club in a standard room on a bed & breakfast basis

The Safari Club offers comfort, personalized service and convenience, located just 10-15 minutes from OR Tambo Airport. There are 17 rooms, a lounge, bar, business center and separate breakfast room. The Safari Club can prepare a light supper for you (needs to be ordered in advance; cost to be paid direct) or arrange a transfer for you to a nearby restaurant or you can choose to have dinner brought in from a number of different restaurants.

May 10th

This morning you will be transferred to OR Tambo Airport for your morning flight to Maun (*to be purchased separately*). Upon arrival in Maun, you will go through Customs & Immigration and then transfer by light aircraft from Maun Airport to Pom Pom airstrip. Flying time approx 20 minutes



In : May 10th Out : May 13th

3 nights at Pom Pom in 1 twin tent with en suite facilities on a full board basis including local drinks, all game viewing activities, and laundry. Pom Pom is located in the heart of the Okavango in a private concession to the west of the Moremi Game Reserve. Apart from great scenery Pom Pom offers day and night game drives, nature walks, fishing, boat and mekoro excursions year round. No activities are offered on the last day as you transfer to your next camp.

May 13th

Transfer by light aircraft from Pom Pom airstrip to Khwai airstrip. Flying time 30 mins



In : May 13th Out : May 16th
3 nights at Khwai Tented Camp in 1 twin tent with en suite facilities on a fully inclusive basis. Khwai Tented Camp is an authentic eight bedded camp situated in the Khwai community area, adjacent to northern Moremi Game Reserve. The Khwai River and its flood plains offers outstanding game viewing opportunities as large concentra-

tions of elephant and buffalo can be seen on a regular basis as well as lion, leopard, cheetah and wild dog. Birdlife is also prolific. Activities include morning and late afternoon game drives, walking and a cultural village outing to the old bushman village of Khwai.

May 16th

Transfer by light aircraft from Khwai airstrip to Kasane Airport. Flying time approx 60 minutes
Transfer the short distance by road from Kasane Airport to Kasane Immigration for boat transfer to Immigration in Namibia and then to the houseboat.

In : May 16th Out : May 18th

2 nights on board Ichobezi Moli or Ichobezi Mukwae house boat in 1 twin cabin with en suite facilities on a fully inclusive basis.

The Ichobezi houseboats are moored at Impalila Island which is situated at the confluence of the Chobe and Zambezi rivers. These specially designed houseboats each have four twin cabins with sliding windows opening onto the water. On the top deck there is a lounge, bar, sun loungers and plunge pool. It's the perfect platform to enjoy the constantly changing panorama as you slowly cruise along the waterways of this diverse and special corner of Africa. You will be enthralled by sightings of a variety of game including hippo, crocodile, elephant, buffalo, giraffe, kudu, waterbuck and the shy Chobe bushbuck. Tender boats are available to ensure that each guest has the freedom to partake in activities that are best suited to their personal interests – these may include birding, fishing, walking and a visit to a local fishing village. Apart from being a birders paradise the area is also famous for great tiger and bream fishing that will challenge the most enthusiastic angler.

May 18th

Transfer by boat from Ichobezi to Kasane Immigration. Meet and greet and transfer by road and boat from Kasane Immigration to the Thorntree River Lodge. Transfer time is approximately 1 hour 30 minutes and immigration and customs must be cleared at both the Zambian and Botswana border posts.

In : May 18th Out : May 21st

3 Nights at Thorntree River Lodge in a twin chalet with en suite facilities on a full board basis including one activity per night. Choice of activities include: a tour of the Falls, sunset cruise or game drive.

Park fees of USD10.00 per person per day is payable locally.

Located just 15 kms upstream from Victoria Falls Thorntree blends naturally into the riverine vegetation and commands superb river views from its main deck and private verandas. In the grounds there is a swimming pool with water level bar and thatched lapa that overlooks a waterhole. Thorntree's riverside location allows for a wide choice of activities including sunset cruises, game drives, fishing, cultural tours and a visit to the Zambian side of the Falls.



Adventure addicts can experience white water rafting, horseback riding, abseiling, bungi jumping, a helicopter ride over the Falls and more - all these activities can be pre-booked and are at additional cost. You can also book most of these once you arrive at Thorntree. If you do want to white water raft, we do recommend that you book this in advance.

May 19th- Optional Elephant Back Safari

For those wanting to experience a truly unique adventure, you have the option of going on an elephant back safari!. It's not just a ride on the largest animal in Africa but an opportunity to interact with these amazing creatures as you witness their skills, intelligence and willingness to respond to instruction. You are collected from your hotel between 06.30 – 07.00 and transferred to a bush site where you will be given a short introductory talk and safety briefing. After being introduced to the elephants and their guides its time to mount. The next 1h30 is spent ambling along trails in the riverine bush and shallow parts of the Zambezi River. On return to the boma there is an opportunity to interact with and feed the elephants before sitting down to a full English breakfast (*the Elephant Back Safari is an optional activity; the price is an additional \$160 if you choose this activity*)

May 21st

Scheduled road transfer from Thorntree River Lodge to Livingstone Airport for your flight home (*flight to be purchased separately*).

South Africa Entry Requirements

You must ensure that your passports have a MINIMUM of two blank/empty visa pages in them. Passports must be valid for 30 days after the intended date of departure. Visitors to South Africa with foreign passports who do not comply with these requirements will either be stopped from boarding their aircraft at their point of departure or risk deportation on arrival in South Africa.

Visas

Please be sure that you have the appropriate visas for this itinerary. You will need a visa for Zambia. You can get this ahead of time or at Immigration upon arrival. Single entry visa fee is \$50 and double entry is \$80.

Medical

As you will be traveling in malarial areas, be sure to take precautions against malaria prior to the commencement of your holiday. Follow your doctor's advice regarding prophylactics and be sure to cover up in the evening and apply repellent.

Insurance

Please be sure that you take out comprehensive travel insurance to safeguard against cancellation and curtailment, medical expenses, repatriation expenses, damage/theft/loss of personal baggage, money and personal belongings.

Baggage

Please note that the baggage allowance on charter flights is 20 kgs per person in a soft bag, including photographic equipment and hand luggage. This is extremely important as too many passengers are travelling with excess baggage or hard suitcases that do not fit into the luggage pod of a light aircraft. Passengers who do not adhere to this baggage regulation delay take off as their pilot has to spend time making alternative arrangements to have their excess baggage or hard suitcases transferred by another aircraft.

If you travel with a hard suitcase or more than 20 kgs of baggage please ensure that you advise us prior to your arrival. We can make arrangements to store luggage in Kasane, it can be flown between Maun and Kasane as unaccompanied baggage for which there will be a charge which must be settled locally. Should you travel with excess baggage or a hard suitcase the pilot flying them out of Maun into their safari camp is completely within his rights to refuse to fly them or their luggage.

Cancellation Policy

It is very important that you are aware of our cancellation policy which comes into force as soon as a booking is made definite. (see Terms & Conditions).

Tipping

Tipping is not mandatory, though it is customary. Only tip if you are happy with the services!

Guides, drivers, waiters and hotel staff can be tipped at your discretion. Tips can be given in the local currency or US dollars. In camp or at your lodge, you'll often find a box for tips. Tips given here will generally be divided among the staff. As a guideline, you may consider tipping your safari guide between \$5-\$10 per day, per person. Some camps have trackers and local experts who share their skills and add to your experience, so you may want to consider a separate tip for them.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

PAYMENT TERMS: A non-refundable deposit for 20% is required at the time of booking. The balance is due 60 days before commencement of the arrangements. If the reservation is made within 60 days of departure the whole amount must be paid at the time of confirmation. If the balance is not received prior to 60 days before departure, Global Sojourns L.L.C. reserves the right to treat the trip as cancelled. All payments may be made by check, bank transfer or major credit card (Visa/MC).

Upon agreement of the itinerary, you will be sent detailed travel information and some forms to fill out. Please review the information and send in a signed liability waiver with your deposit.

CANCELLATION POLICY: It is very important that you are aware of our cancellation policy which comes into force as soon as a booking is made definite. These policies are based on those of the suppliers we are using for this itinerary. Cancellations are only effective on receipt of a written cancellation. Cancellation charges will be levied when travelers cancel their confirmed reservations as follows:

-the traveler's 20% deposit is forfeited if a confirmed booking is cancelled. Cancellations made after the due date of full payment carry a charge, expressed as a percentage of the total booking value, and are as follows:

within 45 days = 30% ;
within 30 days = 50%
within 20 days = 60%
within 15 days = 100%

Please note that we contract services and accommodation of third parties who have their own cancellation policies that may differ from ours and on occasion these must be adhered to. Some parties may require partial or full payment up front in order to confirm a booking - on cancellation this larger deposit may therefore be forfeited as per the third party's cancellation policy.

AIRLINES: The airfare and airport tax quoted are current and are therefore subject to change without prior warning should the airline impose an increase in the rate for any reason. The airfare quoted is based on the lowest class fare available at the time of quoting and is subject to seats being available in that class at the time of booking. Neither Global Sojourns nor our ground operators can be held responsible should airlines discontinue flights on a particular routing or change schedules resulting in missed connections. Should an amendment in a routing or itinerary be necessary we will re-quote accordingly.

TRIP INSURANCE: Global Sojourns, L.L.C. strongly recommends that each participant take out trip insurance- trip cancellation/interruption coverage as well as medical expense and evacuation coverage. This is designed to give you peace of mind and protect you in case of unexpected events such as a medical emergency or if you lose pre-paid, non-refundable trip deposits and payments because of cancellation or trip interruption due to illness, injury, or death of someone in your traveling party, an immediate or extended family member, or a business partner. Typically, these services and expenses are not fully covered by your credit card company, homeowner's policy, and/or medical insurance. We can recommend some companies if you do not already have a company that you use. It is important that you are clear on what exactly they will be covering thus it is recommended that you speak to the insurance company directly.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each client is entirely responsible to ensure that they are in possession of all the necessary travel documents, including a valid passport (with at least 6 months validity after departure from the host country and with sufficient blank pages for each country's immigration stamps and visas requirements), valid visas, air tickets that have you arriving in time for the start of your trip and valid vaccination certificates. For visas, the cost, currency, accepted method of payment and type of visa (i.e. single, double or multiple entry visa) should be checked in advance. This is of particular importance if you are re-entering Zambia from other countries. Border officials in some countries are not in a position to issue visas on the spot hence the need for obtaining visas in advance. Neither Global Sojourns nor our ground operator can be held responsible should the necessary visa not be fulfilled.

MEDICAL INFORMATION: It is each client's responsibility to make sure they are fit enough for the intended trip. It is essential that persons with any pre-existing medical condition(s) and/or dietary restrictions make them known to us well before departure. Be aware that you are traveling in remote geographical areas which may have limited standards of hygiene, sanitation facilities, medical treatment and that medical services, including the presence of a physician or any other trained medical professional and availability of prescription type drugs may be limited or altogether absent. Please note

that many areas of travel within Africa are malarial areas and all travelers must consult their doctors before traveling and ensure that all anti-malarial precautions are taken, followed and advised upon a the time of travel.

WILD ANIMALS: Please be aware that your trip may take you into close contact with wild animals. Attacks by wild animals are rare, but no trip into the African wilderness can guarantee that this will not occur. We cannot be held responsible for any injury or incident on your trip by wild animals or otherwise. Please note that the majority of camps are un-fenced and wildlife moves freely in and around the camps. Always follow the safety instructions from the guides and camp's staff with regards to moving to and from your lodging and while on game activities throughout your trip.

RESPONSIBILITY: Global Sojourns L.L.C. and its owners act only as agents for the clients with respect to services provided, including but not limited to accommodations, activities and all forms of transportation. All tour services are provided by independent contractors who are not controlled by Global Sojourns L.L.C..
